The Bishop of Gloucester, when Bishop of Lewes, was our nearest neighbour in Sussex. We became close friends over the years. When the news of his arrest was made public, my wife Name Redacted and I wrote offering him sanctuary in our house in Sussex, or in London, where he could remain very private, and far from the public eye. We guessed that he might have been taken in by a religious house, and this has turned out to be the case. I am sure this was the best solution.

Meanwhile we have received a heart-rending reply. I cannot imagine a more ghastly situation in which to find oneself. So we would like to help if we possibly can. Is there any way in which I would be allowed to visit him (if he were willing to see me), or still better have him to stay for a week-end?
