



INDEPENDENT INQUIRY CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION CHANGE IN RECOGNISED LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE

1. On various dates between 2016 and 2018, The Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis (“the Commissioner”) was designated as a core participant in the following investigations: Children in the care of Lambeth Council; Accountability and Reparations; The Roman Catholic Church; Westminster; The Internet; and, Children in Custodial Institutions.
2. On 7 March 2018, I issued a notice of determination regarding a change in recognised legal representative in which I designated Dunstan Blay of the Metropolitan Police Services’ legal services directorate as the Commissioner’s recognised legal representative.
3. On 3 September 2018 the Inquiry was informed that Mr Blay had left the Metropolitan Police Service. The Inquiry was subsequently informed that Sarah Heron would now be acting as the Commissioner’s legal representative.
4. Accordingly, as I am satisfied that the Commissioner has now appointed Sarah Heron as its qualified lawyer, I designate Ms Heron of the Metropolitan Police Services’ legal services directorate as its recognised legal representative in the above investigations in accordance with rule 6(1) as I am required by that rule to do.
