### Event

on the evening of the 25/11/2016 [redacted] (young person) approached SD (staff member) and advised that [redacted] (young person) was trying to kiss him and touch him, squeezing his bum and had also tried to put her hands down his trousers.

Approximately 15 minutes later [redacted] approached SD with [redacted] (young person) who gave SD a letter written by [redacted] stating she had witnessed [redacted] make [redacted] engage in sexual activities (Oral Sex). The letter was signed from [redacted] and [redacted]. Both young people stated everything in the letter was true. SD informed the duty manager

DY (deputy manager) spoke to [redacted] and asked her about the conversation she had with SD and the letter she had written and given to SD. [redacted] confirmed that the information in the letter was all true.

on the 25/11/2016 [redacted] said to DY [redacted] had attempted to touch [redacted] private parts, [redacted] told her to get off and so did [redacted]. [redacted] then told [redacted] to do it and [redacted] replied No.

DY then spoke to [redacted] regarding the letter he had given to staff [redacted] first said yeah the letter says everything. [redacted] said that on Thursday (24.11.16) [redacted] had first pulled him into the bathroom and said do you want to have sex with me' in which [redacted] replied 'No'.

[redacted] then stated that [redacted] pulled down [redacted] pants and put her mouth around his middle parts. [redacted] then pulled [redacted] into her bedroom in which [redacted] said 'i'm not allowed in your room' [redacted] then pushed [redacted] onto the bed. [redacted] states that [redacted] then put his middle parts into her middle parts.

This incident was reported to the police.

### Outcome

EDT, parents, social workers for both young people have been notified of the event

Incident has been reported to the police who have visited the home and spoke with [redacted] which investigation is on going

care plans and risk assessments for both [redacted] and [redacted] have been updated

social care have advised that they are currently looking for an alternative placement for [redacted]

CAMHS appointments to be arranged for both [redacted] and [redacted] who currently receive support from CAMHS

### actions to prevent

referral to the MASH team

Supervision plan implemented at the home for [redacted] to be supervised at all times. [redacted] and [redacted] are not to have un supervised interactions at the home.

Nominated staff member identified on each shift to observe [redacted] to ensure that he is safeguarded

Key work to take place for [redacted] on personal space and positive peer relationships

Keywork to take place with [redacted] on positive peer relationships and speaking out

The home to continue to work in conjunction with the police with on going investigation.

Management support put in place over the weekend.
