Re: Redcot & Beechwood, Woodborough Road

In response to your telephone call requesting details of the programme of works for the above, I have pleasure in listing below brief commencement and completion dates for each section of the contract.

Contract commenced 11th June 1973 with the alterations and additions to Redcot, and construction of the observation centre. (It should be noted that Redcot was previously used as a Children's Home and was vacated only a few days before commencement of the contract.

Redcot was completed and handed over to the Social Services Department on Friday 25th January 1974, and occupied by the Social Services Department commencing Monday 28th January 1974 with the move of staff and residents from Beechwood.

Alterations to Beechwood commenced on Monday 28th January.

Reception Centre completed and handed over on the 12th April 1974.

Play Area completed and handed over on the 8th May 1974.

Beechwood completed and handed over to Social Services on the 21st May 1974.
