FOR THE ATTENTION OF THE EARLY INTERVENTION PANEL.

Child was arrested at 2230 hours on Monday 8th March 2004 on suspicion of raping **NO-A478**. He was interviewed at Oxclose Lane Police Station between 1102 and 12.28 on 9.3.04 in the presence of his Mother **Name Redacted** and he denied the allegation. He was subsequently bailed to 1300 on 13.4.04 pending further Police enquiries into the allegation.

The complainant **NO-A478** was video interviewed at the Childrens Development Centre in The City Hospital between 1544 and 1637 hours on 9.3.04 during which time he disclosed that during an incident which took place at 229 Beechdale Road on the morning of Sat 6th March 2004 he was indecently assaulted by **Child**. He alleged that whilst in the "Blue Room" he was wrestling with **Child** who then made an attempt to pull down his trousers. At this time it was alleged that **Child** had pulled his own trousers down and exposed his penis but he was then pushed away by **NO-A478**. **NO-A478** claimed that he ran out of the room and informed a staff member but could not recall who that person was.

Name Redacted (23 years.) Sister of **NO-A478** was present during the video interview in the Observation room. She had been extremely helpful throughout the day and she remarked that she believed that her Brother was wasting everyones time and that he could not be believed.

As the Investigating Officer I had been present with **Name Redacted** when this was said and my own observation of the Interview was that **NO-A478** seemed to be play acting and was not treating the matter seriously but was enjoying the attention. Police enquiries made at 229 Beechdale Road established that **Child** was not present at the home during the morning of Sat 6th March as he got a Bus into Nottingham where he met his Mother.

I would like to express my thanks to Susan Slavin and Hubert Virgo from Woodnook who assisted me fully in my investigation.

In view of what is known at this time there will be no Police action taken against **Child** as the allegation has been proven to be false.
