

Decision 129 – 20th June 2013

Following on from policy decision 118 no further actions will be raised any actions allocated or currently in the ready for allocation queue for **Andris Imantis LOGINS (aka Andy LOGINS)** or **Andy TAYLOR** will be referred to the SIO for finalisation.

Reason

Please refer to the Officer's report completed by Civilian Investigator Mr Mick Pick – June 2013 (Document R12M).

In view of the content of this report, the threshold test has not been met.

NO-A93 and **NO-A315** have both made complaints to the police and have given the name of Andy LOGINS and Mr LOGAN respectively, as persons that they wish to complain about.

NO-A93 has stated on a video interview that she was forced into a car and sat on and as a consequence this caused her to have a miscarriage. It has now been established that **NO-A93** was not pregnant at the time.

I have also been made aware that **NO-A93** has now disclosed to members of my enquiry team that she did not think she was pregnant and it was her solicitor that told her she had been.

In the case of the complainant **NO-A93**, identification is also an issue. The description is not consistent with the other witnesses' accounts.

I have now been told that when **NO-A93** was provided with the name of AT she was able to give his name, whereas on video interview she provided the name of LOGINS not TAYLOR.

I have considered whether there would be any merit in approaching the solicitors regarding the above, however, I have taken the view that **NO-A93** was misguided and she should have indicated whether she was unsure of any of the details of her complaints.

NO-A315 has previously provided a witness statement regarding his complaints. I have examined the content of this statement and it is significantly lacking in detail in regard to the complaints against Mr LOGAN and **NO-F135**. Without further information it is impossible to determine whether the incidents were lawful restraints.

I am aware that efforts have been made to trace and locate **NO-A315** in an effort to clarify the situation however, to date we have been unable to make contact with him.

In the case of **NO-A93** and **NO-A315** the allegations against Andy THORPE/LOGINS would (at most) amount to common assault and are therefore statutory time-barred.
