On this basis Emily told her that the allegations were not going to be looked into again and she was to complain to police complaints if she was not happy with response. Discussed my concern that she may have disclosed further information than originally discussed.

Agreed Clare to get team member to ring **NO-A53** and clarify her referral to police and ensure that this was all looked into and give dates of how old she was as the suspect may all be deceased.

I asked [NO-A53] if I could arrange to visit her to discuss her case. [NO-A53] wanted to know why I wanted to visit now as nothing has been done since Gail Skillen last visited. I explained to [NO-A53] that Gail had been in discussion with the Poilce after her visit and that after the Police spoke to [NO-A53] they established that the allegations had already been investigated at the time and therefore they would not be re opening the case and that they had advised [NO-A53] how she could make a complaint if she was not happy with this. [NO-A53] informed me she has never spoken to the Police about her allegations; not historically or recently and she wanted to know the name of the Police Officer who had been dealing with it. I gave her PC Emily Bocklow's name, after looking through case notes. [NO-A53] requested that I lok through her child care files and get back to her as I would see it was never dealt with. I asked [NO-A53] how she knew that [NO-F235] was deceased and she said because she went to his funeral.

I advised [NO-A53] that I would feedback to my Manager and have a look through her files and then be in touch. I advised her that she had my phone number and if she wanted to speak to me in the meantime or wished for a visit or any other support to give me a call.
