## Formal Strategy Meeting Minutes

This meeting was convened as a result of an indecent assault on [NO-A103] by [Child], a fellow resident at Woodborough Road. He was allegedly touched in his genital area and prevented from leaving his room (see attached report). Although the boys are of a similar age, [NO-A103] is substantially smaller in stature and less mature. [NO-A103] is regularly targeted by other residents as a result of his provocative behaviour. He was very distressed as a result of this incident and this has been subsequently reflected in more extreme forms of behaviour.

[Child] has given his version of events to other residents, which has heightened the level of bullying and intimidation [NO-A103] is exposed to because the other residents are supporting the perpetrator.

[NO-A103]'s background and behavioural difficulties make him a management problem for the unit and ensuring his protection very difficult.
