NO-A533 d.o.b. DPA 66

On 18th February 1981 Mrs. McCalla applied to the Juvenile Court sitting at DPA for an Order under Section 1 of the Children and Young Persons Act 1969 in respect of the above named girl Irrelevant Irrelevant

NO-A533 was represented by Name Redacted of DPA, and her father, Father, attended Court but was not represented.

Evidence in support of the County Council's application was given by Mr. Coombes, social worker from the City Division East Area Office, and Police Constable Cooling who carried out investigations which resulted in a young man being charged with four offences of unlawful sexual intercourse with NO-A533 during the period that she was in the care of the Authority under Section 1 of the Children Act 1948. A question from the Clerk of the Court elicited the fact that the man involved was a residential social worker at Beechwood that the Magistrates did not make any comment on this.

Name Redacted called Father to give evidence on behalf of NO-A533 and Father agreed that if she returned home he could not control her and she should remain in care under a Care Order. Father did not give any evidence on his own behalf and Name Redacted addressed the Court and indicated that he was supporting the County Council's application.

The Magistrates found the case proved, and after reading a report prepared by Mr. Coombes made a Care Order in respect of NO-A533
