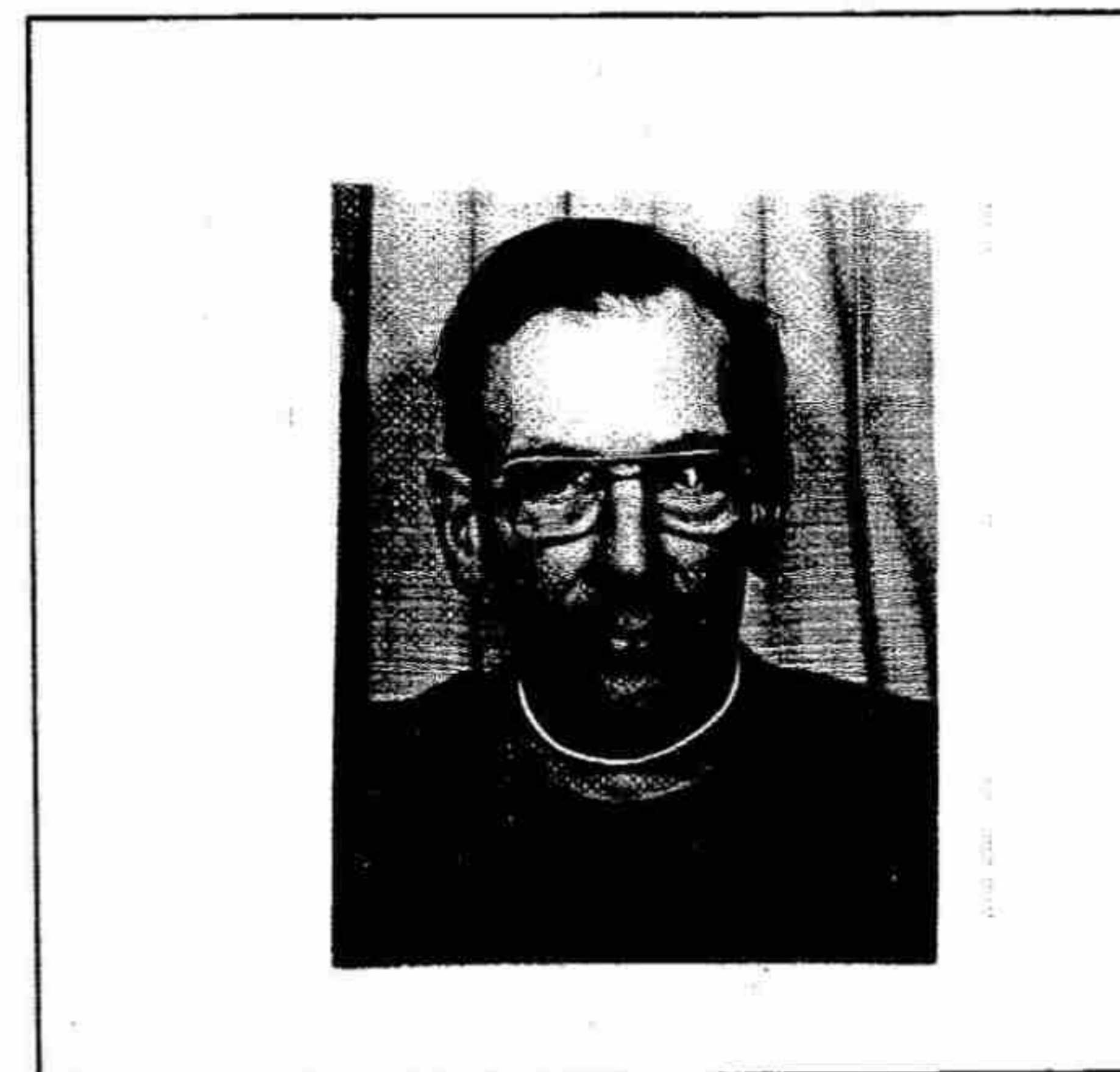

New Town Parish, responsible in my final year for starting the work in the Furnace Green Area of the parish.
- 1965 - 1967 Chaplain to the Dr. Barnardo's Homes at Barkingside and Woodford Bridge, Essex. These were two communities of 600 and 300 children respectively with staff in each of the cottages as well as specialist support staff. This work came to an end with the virtual closure of the Village Homes.
- 1967 - 1973 Chaplain to the Forces, serving with the Army in Germany, Northern Ireland and England.
- 1973 - 1979 Vicar of St. James the Less, Nutley, East Sussex  
A country parish on the Ashdown Forest with some commuters travelling to Brighton and London.
- 1979 - 2003 Vicar of All Saints Church, Eastbourne, East Sussex.  
Seaside parish with a large retired population but also two schools which attend the Family Service and students from the Polytechnic (part of Brighton Polytechnic), the College of Domestic Economy and various Language Schools. Also a seasonal ministry amongst the holiday makers.
- 1980 - Appointed Chaplain to Brighton Polytechnic (Eastbourne)

1997 *Examining Chaplain*
- 1997 - Rural Dean of Eastbourne (continuing after retirement)
