Settlement request – £15k to £20k. Settlement assumed by this stage.</li> <li>2. Legal costs - £15k</li> <li>3. Apology – to be written by +Martin</li> <li>4. Potential for publicity: [Name Redacted] has no desire to do this personally, wanted forewarning of any press release</li> <li>5. No evidence of other concerns or indications of other victim's from survivor's account.</li> <li>6. View of statutory agencies: can any defensible position be made about not disclosing?</li> <li>7. Research evidence – indicates that given that the victim was 7 years old, unlikely to be the only victim, elements of ritualistic language in the abuse.</li> <li>8. Were there other victims, possibly within Kinder transport</li> <li>9. View of [Name Redacted] about disclosure – not strong core</li> <li>10. Transparency – active not passive approach in view of likelihood of public notification by [Name Redacted] solicitor following settlement</li> <li>11. On balance of probabilities, core group believed that other victims could not be ruled out</li> <li>12. Agreed that a third party independent professional opinion should be sought based on an anonymous outline of the case: GT to contact Donald Findlater from Lucy Faithfull Foundation</li> <li>13. May be large scale public interest</li> <li>14. AA to draft initial media statement and consult Press Officer at Lambeth Palace and Comms at Chichester</li> <li>15.
