

NOTE REGARDING CHANGE IN RECOGNISED LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE

1. On 29 February 2016, the former Chair granted an application for core participant status to the Crown Prosecution Service ('CPS') in relation to investigations into institutional failures involving the Anglican Church, Cambridge House, Knowl View and Rochdale, Lambeth Council and the late Lord Janner of Braunstone QC, and for Grainne Galtieri of the Government Legal Department to be the CPS' recognised legal representative.
2. On 14 December 2016, the Inquiry was informed that Ms Galtieri was leaving her current role and so Alasdair Tidball of the Government Legal Department would be acting as the CPS' legal representative in relation to the above investigations henceforth.
3. Accordingly, as I am satisfied that the CPS has now appointed Alasdair Tidball of the Government Legal Department as his qualified lawyer, I designate Mr Tidball as the CPS' recognised legal representative in the investigations involving in accordance with rule 6(1) as I am required by that rule to do.
