He then explained he had used an external hard drive to download files and hidden the hard drive as he was not allowed to possess the item according to his SOPO. He stated to officers that the device contained encryption software. He was then arrested for breaching SOPO. His laptop and external hard drive was seized.	Sentenced to 8 months imprisonment on 12/12/2014
3	RSHO	Offender who is subject to a Risk of Sexual Harm Order allowed a child under 16 into his home address without the child's parent or guardian being present.	12 months imprisonment on 19/12/2011
