was now all in the open. Concerning the phone call from Peter to myself, where he sent me the fax, he spoke of a 'superintendent'. He did not name him. He said he had shown the statement to the superintendent and he was told by this person that it was not criminal. During a later conversation, I think with Bishop Michael, he mentioned a superintendent 'Horn' or with a similar sounding name. I assumed this was the same person that Peter had referred to. I have had no contact with Peter since my phone call to him on 12.12.92. Having read this statement I now recall that during the meeting I had with Neil Todd, **AN-A92** and Nigel Godfrey, I asked Neil what he wanted to happen. He said there were two things. One was that he wanted Peter to admit what was being alleged, and he wanted Peter to cease to be a Bishop.
