In relation to the documents that were given to me by Dame Barbara Castle over a period of about 6 to 8 weeks in 1984, relating to the PIE meetings at Westminster, I would like to state that I did not make any photo copies of any of the documents. Other documents included material that Dame Castle referred to as confidential which I have explained in my previous statement. Again I wish to state that no copies were made of any of the documents that she handed to me. The documents were always kept in the offices of the Bury Messenger under my control. Apart from Dame Barbara Castle, no one else was aware of the documents being in my possession and I never discussed this with anyone else. DPA
