Dear Sir or Madam,

It is with regret that I have to impart to you by way of an anonymous letter the knowledge and information which I consider the Cabinet Office should be aware.

It has come to my attention that certain investigative reporters have uncovered unspeakable facts concerning the personality Jimmy Savile. They have been aware for some time of his homosexual rendezvous with rent boys indeed some years ago, he had considerable trouble which I may add he hid very well with certain of these rent boys.
